OUR FOCUS

We are a movement of students, parents, educators, community leaders and education advocates focused on education equity and racial justice. We will not rest until every student in Oregon has equitable access to a world-class education that prepares them for life beyond the classroom, whether their path leads to college, a career, or both.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Partnering with parents to support their child's education and helping them become strong advocates.



ADVOCACY

We conceptualize data-driven legislation with a focus on statewide solutions, drafted to make the most impact for historically and currently underserved populations. We advocate for policies that help students reach make-orbreak milestones like reading proficiently by the end of third grade, being on track in ninth grade, and graduating from high school.



Policy is only as strong as its implementation; we work tirelessly to ensure that the changes we fight for reach classrooms and directly support students to make measurable gains in achievement.

OUR IMPACT



Stand writes and passes the High School Success Act (Measure 98) at the ballot box.



The High School Success Act is fully funded by lawmakers with \$300 million.



Lawmakers develop (with input from Stand) the Student Success Act, which makes targeted investments statewide.



Now that Measure 98 has been implemented, we see a 6-point increase in graduation rates with gains for every student group.



Stand, in coalition with local organizations, helps elect 4 education champions to Salem-Keizer's school board, creating a student-centered school board.

Stand writes and passes House Bill 2001, which protects culturally and linguistically diverse teachers from being disproportionately affected by layoffs.



Stand successfully advocates for the Early Literacy Success Initiative, which responds to Oregon's early literacy crisis with \$144 million in targeted funding for research-backed strategies.
